Most recently she completed her first term as an at-large member of the Chicago Planning Council representing the SPC.

Audalee is a passionate advocate committed to increasing awareness of the issues surrounding homeless youth, especially pregnant and parenting. Her efforts have included work on the No Child Left Behind task group for CPS; Testifying before the Senate appointed committee evaluating high school completion for pregnant and parenting; Presentation to NAEH Family Homeless Conference 2009; The YTAP (Youth Transitioning to Adulthood) Task
