Felix R. Matlock, Jr. has been the Regional Vice President of Resident Services for Mercy Housing Lakefront, a provider of permanent supportive housing, for the last five years. Prior to joining Mercy Housing Lakefront, Mr. Matlock served as Associate Director-Program Services for The Chicago Christian Industrial League, another supportive housing provider, for seven years. In these roles, he ensured that a comprehensive mix of program services addressing the needs of the homeless population was implemented consistent with the best practices in the field. Mr. Matlock has served as Board President and Board Member on five community organizations. He has contributed well over a decade of work supporting the efforts of the Chicago Plan to End Homelessness, has represented both organizations with SHPA and has co-chaired the SPC Executive Committee for three years.
