In her capacity as Assistant Director to the Mayor Daley’s Office on Domestic Violence, Jeri was responsible for assisting with developing, implementing, managing and directing many of MODV projects and policies as well as coordinating MODV efforts with other city departments, community based organizations and the general public. Jeri staffed the Business and Interfaith Advisory Councils to the MODV office, and chaired the statewide IDHS Teen Dating Violence Sub Committee
