Kenneth Burnett is an active member of the SPC Executive Committee, he has over 14 years of experience managing various programs designed to work with the homeless, reentry, uninsured, medically challenged and the mentally ill communities.

Kenneth has been directly involved with supportive housing programs since 1999, when he served as the Director of Special Needs Housing at Community Supportive Living Systems.

For the past 5 years, Kenneth has served as the Chief Program Officer (CPO) at Christian Community Health Center, a Federally Qualified Health Center that offers primary care and supportive services to the medically underseved and uninsured communities on the south side of Chicago. As the CPO, Kenneth oversees 300 subsidized scattered site permanent housing units and an interim residential homeless program for single women with children.
