Mr. Keibler has been a member of the "tool committee" of the HMV since he began at Catholic Charities 3 1/2 years ago. He attends the HMV Committee and the SPC Committee meetings regularly, as well as SPC All Providers Meetings. Mr. Keibler has developed the role of Catholic Charities as Subsidy Administrator for the DMH Bridge Program since its opening in summer 2009. Catholic Charities provides the function of a housing authority for the program, currently serving over 600 clients in Chicago, Cook and Lake Counties. Additional to his time with Catholic Charities, Mr. Keibler spent over 20 years with the Cook County Housing Authority. His breadth of knowledge in understanding issues of supportive and affordable housing, the landscape of homelessness and the details of housing operations has been significant in improving the quality of programming and understanding the vision for affordable and supportive housing.
