Maura McCauley directs the Heartland Human Care Services’ housing portfolio, inclusive of homeless prevention/rapid re-housing, permanent housing with short-term supports and permanent supportive housing. In addition to programming, Maura provides policy and advocacy leadership as well as program development in the areas of supportive housing and criminal justice. She currently participates in the Planing Council’s task group on the development a coordinated referral list and in the 100k Homes Campaign implementation with families.

Maura has worked in the homeless services field for 13 years, with an emphasis on women and family homelessness and protection from violence, aiding in the transition to self-sufficiency. More recently, she led Heartland’s implementation of Homeless Prevention and Rapid re-housing program, a new resource to Chicago’s homeless system. Maura served as a
