**CENSUS TRAINING FOR  
SERVICE PROVIDERS**

**WHO:** All Chicago homeless service providers are invited to attend the Census Training. Program directors are particularly encouraged to attend.

**WHAT:** The Alliance-led Training will review the general Census process, what's at stake for homeless service providers, and provide clear guidance to ensure people who are experiencing homelessness will be appropriately counted in the 2010 Census.
