**Chicago is creating version two of our Plan to End Homelessness ...

You are invited to join us for a week-long community planning session, known as a **Charrette**. Charrette Week will include two days of expert fishbowls on six community-identified top issue areas, a public feedback session on initial recommendations, and a final report to serve as a foundation for Plan 2.0. The intense facilitated sessions, expertise from across the county and in our own backyard, and insightful comment and feedback loop will sustain our community-driven process and create a strong new Plan.

Expert fishbowls are issue-focused panels that are open to all stakeholders in Chicago. For the first hour, national and local experts will engage in a dialogue that encourages thinking of new system and programmatic responses to ending homelessness in their particular topic area, while the community observes. During the second hour, the community reacts, provides their input, and asks questions. Come to as many fishbowl and feedback sessions as you can!
