

Statewide Call-In Day to Restore Funding for Emergency and Transitional Housing Wednesday, October 26

Earlier this year, the Illinois General Assembly voted to cut the state's Emergency and Transitional Housing program by 52% or \$4.7 million. During the brief fall legislative session, starting this week, we have a big opportunity to right this wrong. Friends, providers, and advocates will be in Springfield the same day spreading the same message.
